

Code of Conduct and Discipline for Students

Students are expected to maintain discipline inside and outside the classrooms/college campus.

Students must be punctual and regular in the classes and House Examinations.

Parents are requested to remain in touch with the faculty members to keep track of the academic performance/conduct of their ward(s).

Students are expected to be courteous and respectful towards all the staff members.

Use of Mobile Phones in the classrooms and library is strictly prohibited.

Smoking, drinking and playing cards in the College campus is strictly prohibited.

Disciplinary action will be taken against those found guilty of causing damage to the College property.

Students must make it a point to read the Notice Board daily. Ignorance of orders/notices duly displayed on the Notice Board shall not be accepted as an excuse for non-compliance.

Students violating rules and resorting to indiscipline are liable to be punished in the form of withdrawal of concession or stipends and even expulsion from the college in extreme cases.

Students who are under-age and do not have a valid driving licence for a two-wheeler or a four-wheeler are advised not to bring their vehicles to the College.

Students must park their vehicles at the cycle/scooter stand.

It is imperative that students be well-behaved and respectful towards other students, especially girls. Anyone indulging in or abetting gang fights or eve-teasing will be dealt with very sternly and may be rusticated.
